- Two letters of recommendation. One letter must be from a current 12th grade teacher or counselor. One letter may be written by any adult, (not a relative).

Applicants must submit completed applications and all requested material to the Burbank Police Foundation by February 28, 2019. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
